#### **First Essex X10**

##### **Basildon - Wickford - Chelmsford - Stansted Airport**

Running hourly from Basildon, the X10 operates 23 hours a day, 364 days a year using brand new midibuses. Interestingly, their replacement of coaches was categorised by the company as an improvement; it's definitely worth a ride to see if you arrive at the same conclusion as them.

#### **First Essex 100**

##### **Chelmsford - Billericay - Basildon - Grays - Lakeside**

Hybrid bus operation isn't so prevalent outside of London, and even rarer is the operation of Volvo 7900H buses; these are the mainstay on service 100 and are presented in a First Hybrid livery. This hasn't been adopted elsewhere in UK Bus, so this service really is full of rarities!

#### **Amber Coaches 374**

##### **Basildon - Stanford le Hope - Tilbury - Grays**

Recently acquired by NIBS, Amber Coaches are a well established coach operator in Essex, and run four bus routes in the county. The 374 links Basildon with the busy town of Grays, where passengers can connect with TfL bus services to complete their journeys into London.
