Arriva Southern Counties Colchester Park & Ride

Central Colchester - Colchester North Park & Ride (circular)

Arriva's win of the Colchester P&R contract with 5 new midibuses affirmed its interest in the Essex town. Buses leave at least every 15 minutes from Monday to Saturday from 7am, with bus priority measures along the route and a daily ticket allows unlimited travel.

Hedingham Omnibuses 87/87A

Colchester - University of Essex - Alresford - Brightlingsea

Hedingham's profitability has dwindled since the Go-Ahead takeover some years ago, but its reputation still stands strong in the urban towns and rural villages of Essex. Refurbished double deckers cascaded from the group's London operations are the mainstay on this route.

First Eastern Counties 76

Colchester - University Of Essex - Frating - Weeley - Clacton

First are the dominant operator in both Clacton and Colchester, and this bus service links the two towns. Providing a great cross-county link for students at the University of Essex, the 76 also carries passengers bound for the Clacton seaside. Vehicle allocation is usually varied too!
