Metrobus Fastway 10

Bewbush - Broadfield - Crawley - Manor Royal - Gatwick Airport

Considering that Arriva withdrew from Crawley in 2001 citing the lack of commercial viability, the subsequent growth of Metrobus' network is extremely impressive. Notably, the Fastway 10 serving Gatwick Airport has received new fleet and runs 24/7; up to every 6 minutes in the daytime.

Metrobus 400

Brighton - Peacehaven - Newhaven - Seaford - Eastbourne

A refurbished fleet of buses have entered service on route 400, and are the first batch of double deckers to sport the company's new cool blue livery, designed by Best Impressions. Dedicated route branding with average journey times between each main stop add to the passenger experience.
