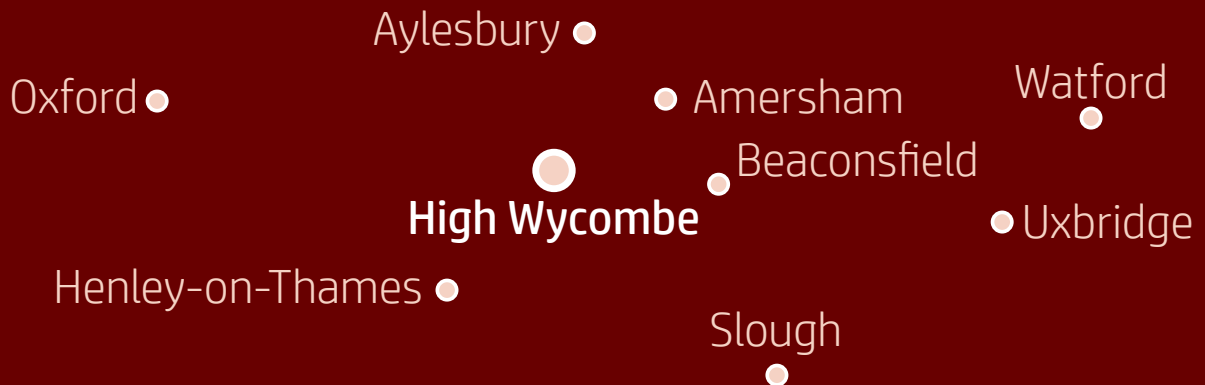

Arriva the Shires/Carousel Buses 'The One'

High Wycombe - Hazlemere - Amersham - Chesham

In March 2013, Bucks CC brokered a partnership between the town's two principal operators to combine their Wycombe - Chesham services into The One. The Blue One and Red One run a combined frequency of every 15 minutes, and each operator accepts the other's return and day tickets.

Arriva the Shires 33

Castlefield - High Wycombe - Totteridge

For some time, Arriva's High Wycombe has been starved of investment in new vehicles, so 2015's delivery of 5 Streetlite WF buses was most welcome; allocated to route 33, they traverse across this hilly town - it will be interesting to see how these lightweight buses perform in such terrain.

Carousel Buses Regatta X80

High Wycombe - Henley-on-Thames - Shiplake - Reading

A new entrant to the bus scene in Reading, Carousel takes on Arriva's long standing 800/850 services on the High Wycombe - Reading corridor. With 'Regatta' branded micro-hybrid buses, this service has garnered increasing patronage since its inception. It's worth a ride to see what they're doing right.

High Wycombe - Beaconsfield - Gerrards Cross - Uxbridge - Heathrow Airport

Carousel's dedicated 'link' services to Uxbridge and Heathrow Airport have seen impressive levels of growth in recent years, and this success is now being matched with increased investment in the form of new vehicles - they herald the first of such since the company's takeover by Go-Ahead.
