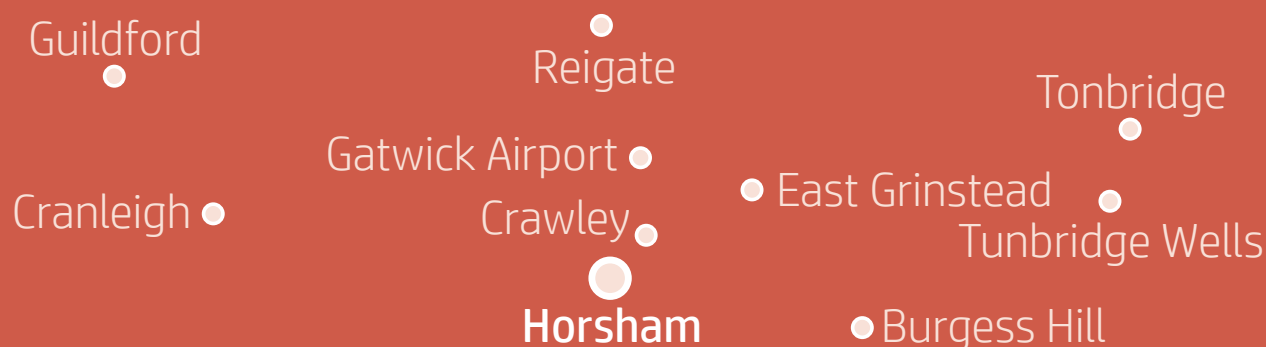

Horsham - North Heath - Bewbush - Gatwick Airport

Metrobus have a reputation for building robust, quality services, and the 200 is certainly no exception. A new fleet arrived in 2015 and whilst sported a revitalised Metrobus livery, were also kitted out with WiFi, USB/mains sockets and external, off-bus, service announcements.

Arriva Southern Counties 63/63X

Horsham - Cranleigh - Guildford

In October 2009 the Horsham depot and routes were sold to Metrobus with 19 buses. Indeed, Arriva don't have many services running into this part of Sussex anymore - indeed just the one. Route 63 operates from their Guildford and extends from Cranleigh to Horsham once an hour.
