Arriva the Shires 7

Bletchley - Furzton - Central Milton Keynes - Stantonbury - Wolverton

In 2012, six organisations signed a five year collaboration agreement committing to the replacement of seven diesel buses with their all-electric counterparts on one of the main bus routes in the city in 2014, removing 500 tonnes of CO₂ emissions as well as 45 tonnes of other tailpipe emissions.

Arriva the Shires F70

Milton Keynes - Leighton Buzzard - Dunstable - Luton

This service makes use of the Luton Dunstable Guided Busway to ensure faster end-to-end travel times. It's currently the only interurban service to do so and it has simplified the travel experience for bus passengers.

Stagecoach (East) X5

Oxford - Milton Keynes - Bedford - Cambridge

The X5 service runs seven days a week between renowned cities, Oxford and Cambridge. Whether you're planning a day trip, watching the boat race, or commuting to work, the X5 will get you there. Coaches are fitted with reclining seats, air conditioning, wash facilities, WiFi & mains charging points.

Arriva the Shires Max X60

Milton Keynes - Buckingham - Aylesbury

In September 2014, Arriva launched the Max brand for interurban express services. Arriva the Shires later adopted this for an express incarnation of the Aylesbury - Milton Keynes route. As with the Sapphire 280, growth has been above expectations, and modal shift from car use is evidenced.
